- 164 horses tested for gait and predicted at 99.4% accuracy.

- Ability to predict mares foaling date within 6 hours by testing mare's milk for calcium and PH levels.
- Standardbred mares have a foaling range that leads to greater possibility of unattended foaling. A mare foaling unattended for 10 minutes decreases survival rate by 10%.
